

LWV Statement on Ohio's Voter Purge Case

Justice Department Flip Flops on Voting Rights in Ohio Purge Case

Washington, DC - League of Women Voters **President Chris** Carson issued the following statement in response to the latest Department of Justice brief filed in Husted v. A. Philip Randolph Institute, a pending Supreme Court case concerning Ohio's voter purge: "By changing their position in the 2016 Ohio voter purge, the Justice Department is playing politics with our democracy and threatening the fundamental right to vote. We have seen this administration lay the
